

Appendix A

Admission Requirements:

- (1) Evidence of high school graduation OR minimum 19 years of age.
- (2) Prior to acceptance, applicants must meet at least **one** of the following language proficiency requirements:
 - Completion of 2 years of secondary education (including English 10 and 11 with a grade of ‘C’ or higher) from a country where English is one of the principal languages. This may be demonstrated by providing a high school transcript, completion of a BC Adult Graduation program or providing international education credentials recognized through WES, ICES, or IQAS. **OR**
 - Completion of 2 years of full-time post-secondary education at an accredited institution where English is the language of instruction. Language development courses (i.e., ELL courses) cannot be included in this calculation. International education credentials recognized through WES, ICES, and IQAS **OR**
 - Provide verified results for one of the English language proficiency tests listed below. Test results must be dated no more than two years before the start date of the program.
